# CCMSB Policy Governing Benevolence Committee and Benevolence Fund Version 1.0

Effective: February 19, 2017

### 1. Purpose:

To help those with unexpected and urgent financial needs as guided by biblical teachings (Acts 20:33-35; II Cor 8:13-15; Gal 6:9-10; I Tim 5:16, 6:17-19; Heb 13:16).

# 2. Organization:

The committee shall consist of the caring minister/pastor and two or three additional church members. The chairman shall be one of the lay members appointed by the Board of Deacons.

#### 3. Member Qualification

Member of CCMSB, recommended by the chairperson and confirmed by BOD.

#### 4. Term of Service

Two-year, can be reappointed.

# 5. Responsibility

Safe keeping and administration of the benevolence fund.

# 6. Fund Administration Policy

- A. Fund recipient candidate: individual or organization with needs, with higher priority to individuals who attend our church.
- B. Recipient obligation: none.
- C. Source of fund: Thanksgiving offering. Offerings designated for this fund is encouraged.
- D. Decision authority:
  - 1. All decisions will be made by the committee.
  - 2. Each recipient is limited to a total of \$2000 a year.
- E. Recipient nomination: members and friends are encouraged to nominate recipient candidates to any committee members. All cases will be handled in strict confidence.
